# OVERVIEW

International Association of Public Transport (UITP) is the international network for public transport authorities and operators, policy decision-makers, scientific institutes and the public transport supply and service industry. It is a platform for worldwide cooperation, business development and knowledge sharing for its 1,400 member organisations from 96 countries.

UITPANZ is the International Association of Public Transport Australia/New Zealand. We are the regional office responsible for all UITP activity across Australia and New Zealand representing the interests of over 60 member organisations.

Together, UITP and UITPANZ work to enhance global quality of life and economic well-being by supporting and promoting sustainable transport in urban and regional areas.

## VISION

UITPANZ is the leading public transport industry body in Australia and New Zealand covering all public transport modes and all relevant sectors. Our vision is to realise world class, integrated and sustainable public transport systems across Australia and New Zealand where public transport is an attractive and accessible choice for travel.

## MISSION

We advocate for positive change leading to public transport patronage growth. This contributes to the UITP's global aim to double the market share of public transport worldwide by 2025, from the base year of 2011. This ambition is known as 'PTx2'.

We work with our membership base to identify and understand the evolving needs of the public transport sector across policy, planning, and operating dimensions. We leverage our extensive national and international networks for knowledge, technical information, and best practice sharing. We strive to deliver value to our members by influencing and shaping policy debates at local, regional, state, and federal levels.

## OBJECTIVES

To make our vision a reality and deliver on our mission, the objectives of UITPANZ are to:

- facilitate knowledge exchange, member connectivity and networking opportunities within our local, national and international networks
- lead and influence policy debates on public transport issues, including demonstrating the broader social, environmental and economic benefits of public transport
- share, advocate, and celebrate best practice in public and active transport
- inspire the next generation of public transport leaders in Australia and New Zealand
- sustain the financial viability of the organisation in order to meet current and future challenges.

### *Policy and Advocacy*

With links to the UITP's head office based in Brussels, Belgium and close links to the regional and liaison offices around the world, UITPANZ can put you in touch with who and what you need to know for public transport issues.

The UITP proudly organises the Global Public Transport Summit, a unique biennial event that covers all urban and regional transport modes. This capstone event combines a full program of congress sessions with an extensive exhibition of the latest solutions, innovations and products in public transport and urban mobility ; it is the premier industry networking opportunity.

### *Conferences, Forums and Events*

In addition to assisting with the Global Public Transport Summit, every year, UITPANZ runs conferences and other events to bring members together to discuss topics of common interest for public transport in Australia and New Zealand.
